BIG IDEA

God gave us a mission.

THE BIBLE

The Great Commission: Matthew 28:16-20;
(Romans 10:14-15)

QUESTIONS

- Who gave us a mission? What is the special name of the mission?
- What is this mission?
- What are the three things Jesus tells us to do in that mission?
- Romans 10:15 says, "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!" What does this verse mean to you?
- Where are some places you can "make disciples"?
- Why do you think God gave us this mission?
- Who would you like to tell about Jesus?

ACTIVITY

- *Read Romans 10:15b to the kids.* This Bible verse we just read says delivering the good news about Jesus is so precious that even the person delivering the news (and their feet!) are beautiful!
- **INSTRUCTIONS:** *Pass out a blank sheet of paper and have kids take off their shoes and trace their feet. Give out markers, crayons, colored pencils, and/or paint, in addition to stickers and other decorative elements. Have them decorate inside the outline of their feet, making unique abstract art!*
- Who can you share the good news of Jesus with? *Write their name on your foot!*
