THE BIBLE

Story Title: Joshua 3:10-4:9;
(Psalm 136)

QUESTIONS

- Why did the Israelites build an altar after crossing the Jordan River?
- Why were there twelve stones?
- Can you remember other times in the Bible where God's people were told to remember what God had done?
- Read Joshua 4:6b-7. Imagine one of the kids in the Bible story had asked you, "What do these stones mean?" How would you explain it to them?
- Do you or your family have things you do to remember events that have happened before?
- What are some things we do at church to remind us of things God has done?
- Why is it important to remember?

ACTIVITY

Find a medium-sized smooth stone and permanent marker. Invite them to write a word or draw a picture or symbol to remind them of something God has done for them. Encourage them to carry the stone with them as a reminder.
