THE BIBLE

Gideon Asks for a Sign: Judges 6;
(Philippians 4:7)

QUESTIONS

- Why was God not pleased with the Israelites at the time when Gideon lived?
- What did God tell Gideon?
- What did Gideon think about this? How did he react?
- Read Judges 6:39-40. Gideon asked God for signs to make sure he heard God correctly. Have you ever done something like this to God?
- Why do you think God chose Gideon to free the Israelites?
- If you were Gideon, would you have reacted the same way, needing reassurance that you heard God correctly?
- How do you think it makes God feel when we don't trust God? Do you think it's okay to ask for reassurance like Gideon did?

ACTIVITY

Make a [Cut & Tie blanket](#) to keep as a reminder or to give away to an organization in need.

Gideon wanted to be sure he heard God correctly. When the fleece was wet, it was a sign to Gideon that God was with him and it gave him peace. We are going to make fleece tie blankets and donate them to people in need (*be specific if you have the information about where the blankets will go*). Hopefully, these blankets we create will bring peace to someone who needs it.
